

**VILLAGE OF BOYLE  
BYLAW 05-17**

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**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BOYLE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, REQUIREING EVERY NOMINATION FOR THE OFFICE OF COUNCILLOR OF THE VILLAGE OF BOYLE TO BE ACCOMPANIED BY A CASH DEPOSIT IN THE ORDER OF CASH, CERTIFIED CHEQUE OR CASH ORDER OR MONEY ORDER.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 29 and Section 30 of the Local authorities Election Act of Alberta, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter L-21 allow a municipality to require every nomination for the office of Councillor of the Village of Boyle in the Province of Alberta to be accompanied by a cash deposit in the form of cash, certified cheque, or cash order or by money order,

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Village of Boyle in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, and under the authority of the Municipal Government Act M26 and the Local Election Authorities Act of the Province of Alberta 2000 Statutes Chapter L21 with amendment in force as of May 14, 2014 enacts as follows.

**HEREBY ENACT AS FOLLOWS:**

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Nomination Deposit Bylaw.
2. Every nomination for the office of Councillor shall be accompanied by a cash deposit of \$100.00.
3. Every nomination deposit shall be in the form of cash, certified cheque or cash order or by money order.
4. The returning officer shall return the nomination deposit to a candidate if:
  - a) The candidate is declared elected;
  - b) If the candidate obtains a number of votes at least equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the total number of votes cast for the elected candidate with the least number of votes;
  - c) If the candidate withdraws his / her name as a candidate in accordance with Section 32 of the Local Authorities Election Act of the Province of Alberta, 2000 Chapter L-21 with amendments in force as of May 14, 2014;
  - d) If a candidate dies before the closing of the voting stations on Election Day, the sum deposited by the candidate shall be returned to the candidate's estate.
5. The returning officer shall not return the nomination deposit if the candidate does not obtain a number of votes at least equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the total number of votes cast for the candidate elected with the least number of votes and the forfeited nomination deposit shall be paid into the general revenue of the Village of Boyle.
6. This bylaw shall take effect on the date of the final reading thereof.
