Qualifications and Requirements are subject to but not limited to:

- Grade 12 or equivalent.
- Ability to safely operate the equipment and tools as required for the position such as scrubbers, sweeper, snow blowers, lawnmowers, and miscellaneous small electrical and mechanical equipment.
- Knowledge of standard methods, materials, safety precautions, WHMIS and hazards involved in the construction and maintenance of specific assignments.
- Experience with janitorial or custodial work is an asset.
- Arena Icemaker Level 1 or 2, or willing to achieve.

Duty details: Parks / Facility / Arena Labourer

The Village of Boyle features amenities, including arena, splash park, skate park, outdoor ball diamonds and soccer fields, walking trails, RV park, several playgrounds, basketball, and tennis courts. We contribute to the health, safety, and enjoyment of all guests by helping to maintain the operations at our facilities.

This position during the summer months will focus on grass cutting, field maintenance, washroom cleaning, garbage removal and facility building maintenance, working standard 40 hour work week. During the winter months, the employee will be dedicated to arena maintenance and operation, working shift work including evening and weekends.

Reporting to the Superintendent of Public Works (or the designate) and working in coordination with Public Works, the position will perform maintenance and public relations duties within all outdoor and indoor facilities to ensure that they are readily available in an attractive, clean, safe, and presentable condition for public use. This position provides direct customer services to user groups and the public. The position includes but are not limited to the following seasonal responsibilities;

Winter Responsibilities include:

- Perform janitorial and preventative maintenance
- Perform housekeeping duties throughout the Arena
- Snow removal as required using hand and/or light powered operating equipment.
- Moving nets and performing snow removal as required
- Open, monitor and close arena facility
- Ensure all rules and regulations pertaining to the facilities are adhered to
- Maintain positive public relations and provide assistance and information services to user groups and the public
- Operate the Ice Resurfacer and Zamboni
- Monitor the refrigeration plant to ensure the operations right parameter that includes the refrigerant alarm system
- Ensures quality ice resurfacing to accommodate various on ice activities by installing, removing, marking and maintaining the ice surface
- Checks HVAC equipment, machinery and toiletry supplies
- Monitors arenas to ensure rental clients adhere to the scheduled ice times and are acting appropriately within the arena dressing rooms
- Provides quality customer service to a wide variety of arena users by aiding with concerns and questions
- Assists with checking the condition of the boards, ice thickness, glass, netting and areas in the arena during weekly ice maintenance times and make repairs as necessary
- Participates in arena facility shutdown and start-up
