Fortis Contract for Streetlights - There is a shortfall of \$71,361.83 in the budget however here is a projected savings of \$25,0000 from the roadway project. The complete projected shortfall will be between \$45,000.00 and \$70,000.00.

There was great savings made from recycling pavement and concrete leaving the village with material for road repair for years to come.
