COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION

Community Transportation services are provided to seniors and disabled individuals residing within the boundaries of Athabasca County, Town of Athabasca and Village of Boyle. The service is overseen by the Community Transportation Committee, with the finances and vehicle maintenance being administered by Athabasca County.

Each of the participating municipalities contributes towards the financial operation of the Community Transportation Service as agreed upon annually by the municipal council. Financially the service operates on a break-even basis, with no operational or capital deficits unless approved in advance of all three partners.

The service may be provided to assist any disabled citizen or citizen over the age of 60 who resides within the boundaries of Athabasca County, the Town of Athabasca or the Village of Boyle.

There are 2 wheelchair assessable vehicles utilized to deliver the service; a Handi-Bus and a Handi-Van.

DEVELOPMENT & BUILDING PERMITS

Contact the Village office at 780-689-3643 to find out what permits & permissions you require.

Development Permit - Once the Village has received a completed Development Application there is a minimum 21 day waiting period before any work can begin.

Building Permit are required for the following: hot tubs, swimming pools, decks, woodstoves, basement developments and minor and major renovations, garages, sheds, storage buildings, new structures, and mobile homes. Any structure larger than 10'x10', any renovations that involve structural work and work that exceeds \$5000.00

A permit in the Gas Discipline is required to install, alter, or add to the gas system.

A permit in the Electrical Discipline is required to install, alter, or add to an electrical system.

A permit in the Plumbing Discipline is required to install, alter, or add to the plumbing system.
