



## Municipal Policy Manual

CODE: 10-90

CATEGORY: Sports Assistance Grant

### RATIONALE:

The Council of the Village of Boyle may consider contributing funds to local individuals and organizations that have progressed in their sport to Zone and/or Provincial level or to the Alberta Summer and/or Winter Games based on the following criteria:

### GUIDELINES:

1. Funds may be provided to individuals and / or organizations where residents of the Village of Boyle participate, provided that the individuals and / or organizations are solely non-profit and organized by a Volunteer Group.
2. All local sports may be considered by the Council of the Village of Boyle.
3. The Council of the Village of Boyle may consider mileage and / or accommodation costs only in determining grant eligibility. Only the expenses of team members and two team assistants will be considered.
4. Any individual group must apply in writing to the Council of the Village of Boyle through Village Administration and / or his / her designate outlining the following:
  - a) the team members and team assistants
  - b) The distance in kilometers to be traveled
  - c) The cost of accommodations and the length of stay
  - d) An indication of the place of residence of the team members
  - e) Who the assistance grant should be payable to
  - f) A brief history of the sport in the community
  - g) The number of participants involved in the sport
5. Funding will be to a maximum as per Fee Schedule #00-20
6. Requests for donations may be referred to the Athabasca Regional Recreation and Learning Connection Board (ARRLCB).
7. The Village of Boyle Recreation Committee is responsible for accepting requests to reduce or waive facility rental fees for all recreation facilities under its jurisdiction. Recommendations will be forwarded to the Council of the Village of Boyle.
8. All funding and / or requests are contingent upon approval of the Council of the Village of Boyle.
