



HYDRANT FLUSHING

**Please be advised, hydrant maintenance and flushing will be commencing in the next 2 weeks
June 6th through the end of June.**

Hydrant flushing is the quick release of water from fire hydrants a controlled procedure that is vital to the general maintenance of the villages' water distribution system. It helps maintain the water clarity and quality by clearing iron and mineral deposits from the water mains (distribution pipes).

You may notice that your water is cloudy or may even have a brown tint when hydrant flushing is being performed in your area. This is from additional air particles being trapped in the water as it moves through the lines at a high speed. Sometimes hydrant flushing can make the water temporarily appear rust-colored because the iron and mineral deposits. This cloudy or tinted water is still safe to use and consume during hydrant flushing, but it may stain laundry. Please flush your taps after the hydrant flushing to help wash away any residual particles that may have entered your water line."
