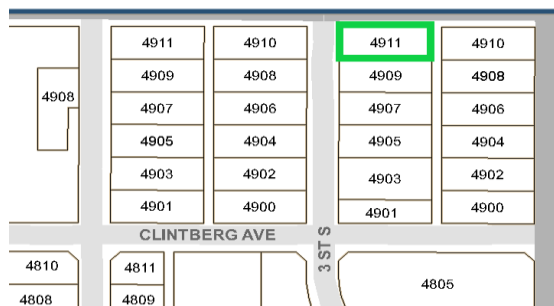

#### Bylaw and Additional Information

Village of Boyle Land Use Bylaw Amendment 05-23

- That Lot 7 Block 9 Plan 290HW, being 4911 – Third Street South, as shown on the attached map, outlined in green, be rezoned from its current designation of C1 Commercial District to R1 Low Density Residential District.



A Public Hearing regarding the proposed bylaw will be held Wednesday, October 4, 2023, at 7:00 pm in the Council Chambers at the Village Office (4800 3<sup>rd</sup> St South). The style of the hearing will be structured and persons wishing to speak will be requested to sign in and state their name and address for the record upon being recognized by the Chair. Council will hear submissions made in person or by the agent from any person who claims to be affected by the proposed bylaw. Any person wishing to submit written comments may do so by sending them to The Village of Boyle, at the address below. Comments received prior to 4:00 p.m. on October 3, 2023, will be included in the staff report to Council and comments received after will be read at the public hearing. Persons may make oral presentations at the Council meeting, regardless of whether or not they have provided written comments.
