REGISTER TO VOTE

The Village of Boyle Election will be held on October 20th, 2025. With the proclamation of the Municipal Affairs Statutes Amendment Act, 2024, municipalities are required to maintain a permanent Electors Register of residents who are eligible to vote. **Any Individuals who wish to vote on election day must first be registered.**

To be ready to vote, please register to vote and confirm your information by visiting <u>WWW.voterlink.ab.ca</u>, from which the Village receives its list of eligible voters. To vote in the 2025 municipal election in the Village of Boyle, you must be:

- At least 18 years of age;
- A Canadian Citizen,
- A resident of the Village of Boyle

At the voting station, voters MUST provide identification that proves your identity and current residence
