DEVELOPMENT & BUILDING PERMITS

Contact the Village office at 780-689-3643 to find out what permits & permissions you require.

Development Permit - Once the Village has received a completed Development Application there is a minimum 21 day waiting period before any work can begin.

Building Permit are required for the following: hot tubs, swimming pools, decks, woodstoves, basement developments and minor and major renovations, garages, sheds, storage buildings, new structures, and mobile homes. Any structure larger than 10'x10', any renovations that involve structural work and work that exceeds \$5000.00 A permit in the Gas Discipline is required to install, alter, or add to the gas system.

A permit in the Electrical Discipline is required to install, alter, or add to an electrical system.

A permit in the Plumbing Discipline is required to install, alter, or add to the plumbing system.
