Spring Transition Public Works Update

Keeping Our Community Safe & Clean This Spring!

As the snow melts and temperatures rise, our Public Works team is hard at work ensuring a smooth transition into spring. Here's what we're focusing on to keep our roads, parks, and infrastructure in top shape.

Drainage & Flood Prevention

- **Storm Drain Cleaning:** Clearing catch basins and culverts to prevent flooding.
- **Ditch & Drainage Maintenance:** Removing debris to ensure proper water flow.

Snow & Ice Management Transition

- **Melting Snow Management:** Removing excess snow from roads and public spaces to prevent pooling water.
- **Equipment Transition:** Our fleet is shifting from snowplows to street sweepers and road repair vehicles.

Road Maintenance & Repairs

- **Pothole Repairs:** Our crews are busy filling potholes caused by winter's freeze-thaw cycles.
- **Street Sweeping:** We're clearing sand, gravel, and debris left from winter road maintenance.
- **Line Painting:** Road markings and crosswalks are being refreshed for improved visibility and safety.

Parks & Green Spaces

- **Tree & Brush Cleanup:** Removing winter-damaged branches and trees.
- **Grass & Field Preparation:** Mowing, fertilizing, spraying for weeds, and prepping public spaces and sports fields.
- **Trail & Park Maintenance:** Repairing pathways, benches, and playgrounds.

Utility & Infrastructure Maintenance

- **Water Main & Sewer Checks:** Addressing any winter-related damage and ensuring proper function.
- **Fire Hydrant Flushing:** Testing and clearing hydrants to maintain emergency readiness.

- Report potholes, drainage issues, or fallen trees to Administration 780-689-3643.
- Keep storm drains near your home clear of leaves and debris.
- Use caution around road maintenance crews as they work to improve our community.

UTILITY FEES & CHARGES - CHANGES APRIL 1, 2025

The first reading of Bylaw 01-25 (Fees and Charges) was passed on February 19, 2025. This Bylaw is scheduled for second and third readings at the April 2, 2025, Council Meeting.

The proposed changes are as follows:

- The gas infrastructure fee will be **removed** - \$5.00
- The recycling fee will be **removed**, and services will be increased to once a week - \$10.15
- A fire protection infrastructure fee will be **added** - \$2.00
- The solid waste fee will be **increased** by \$3.00

*****The minimum monthly rates have been reduced by \$10.15 and recycling services will increase weekly*****
