Due to increasing wildfire risk, and early fire activity in the region, a complete Fire Ban is now in effect and all fires must be extinguished.

Under this Ban: https://www.albertafirebans.ca/

-The issuance of new fire permits is prohibited.

-All existing permits are suspended.

-The lighting of outdoor fires is prohibited.

Including all open fires, campfires, fires used for cooking, briquette barbecues, burning barrels, chimeneas and portable wood burning fire pits.

-The discharge of fireworks and use of exploding targets is prohibited. The use of Off Highway Vehicles (OHVs) is prohibited on public lands. For greater clarity, go to the Alberta Fire Ban site at https://www.albertafirebans.ca/

Large Loads may be acceptable at the Athabasca Regional Landfill or the Boyle Landfill at set tip fees. Please call for information and Hours of Operation.

(MAERS) My Alberta Emergency Registration System

Why? They provide a secure online portal that allows *Albertans to register themselves in the case of (or during an emergency).* Individuals and household members including that of their companion animals, who may be required to evacuate from their homes, are able to enter basic personal information into MAERS. Once information is entered into MAERS, a Government of Alberta designate then manually uploads it to the Registered Reception Centre Program (RRCP). Once information is available to the RRCP System, Local Authorities are able to provide Emergency Social Services to the Albertan.

For Albertans without internet access, 310-0000 call centre staff are trained to enter the Albertans basic information directly into the RRCP System.
