



Canada Post Strike - Effective October 8, 2025

As of Thursday, September 25, 2025, Canada Post workers are on strike, which will disrupt mail delivery and cause delays in receiving your utility bills and other correspondence from the Village of Boyle.

During the strike, the Village of Boyle may be unable to mail customer utility bills, notices, or account information. Outgoing mail will be held at the Village of Boyle office during business hours, Monday to Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Utility bills will be processed in early October. Please note that payments are still due on the specified deadline date, and late penalties will apply.
