## PROPERTY TAX LATE PENALTY REIMBURSEMENT

The Alberta Government is providing some relief through property tax late penalty reimbursement. If a penalty was incurred before December 15, 2022, an application would have to be submitted by March 15, 2023. Any penalty after December 15, 2022, the application must be made within 90 days of the penalty being incurred and it is their decision on reimbursement. Go to the link to find out more.

## DEVELOPMENT & BUILDING PERMITS

Contact the Village office at 780-689-3643 to find out what permits & permissions you require.

**Building Permit are required for the following:** hot tubs, swimming pools, decks, woodstoves, basement developments and minor and major renovations, garages, sheds, storage buildings, new structures and mobile homes. Any structure larger than 10'x10', any renovations that involve structural work and work that exceeds \$5000.00

**A permit in the Gas Discipline is required** to install, alter or add to the gas system.

**A permit in the Electrical Discipline is required** to install, alter or add to an electrical system.

**A permit in the Plumbing Discipline is required** to install, alter or add to the plumbing system.
