Notice:

Village of Boyle Fire Ban Effective July 31, 2025

Due to extremely dry conditions and an increased risk of wildfires, the Village of Boyle has enacted a FIREBAN.

Fire bans are issued to inform citizens of conditions that pose a high fire risk and the potential danger caused by open fires. Under this Ban: The lighting of outdoor fires is prohibited.

Including all open fires, campfires, fires used for cooking, briquette barbecues, burning barrels, chimeneas and portable wood burning fire pits.

The discharge of fireworks and use of exploding targets is prohibited.

The use of off-highway vehicles (OHVs) is prohibited on public lands.

This OHV restriction does not apply to OHVs operated as part of emergency response operations.

This Fire Control Order comes into effect at 2:00 o'clock p.m. on the 31st day of July 2025, and will remain in effect until amended or revoked by the proper authority of the Village of Boyle.
